Session Thoughts:

- Write down anything that was new, interesting or helpful to you.

We must remember that God's supernatural provision often comes in very physical and natural ways. The danger we face is that we will begin to place our trust in the physical means and not God himself.

Discussion Questions:

1. Have there been times in your life when you saw God provide for you in tangible ways?
2. Have you had the experience of trying to walk in the Lord's will and being confronted by the fear of him not providing? Are there other fears that you entertain as you try to be faithful to God's will?
3. What is the significance of Jesus placing "the will of God & the Kingdom of God" before "the provision of God" in the sequence of the Lord's Prayer? In light of this what "right" do we have to claim the provision of God?
